- Conducted FCA basketball camp for 70 children
- Landscaped the grounds at Next Step and helped sort for their community store.
- Sent multiple teams to spend time with the fine folks at the Adult Day Care in town
- Volunteered at Nona's Nest....a resource hub for foster families.
- Volunteered at the UK Extension Office
- Sent multiple teams to volunteer at a community kids' club
- Painted, deep cleaned, and organized the resource pantry at Community Action
- Volunteered at a local homeless shelter
- Assisted with prep for a summer camp for kids with special needs
- Served at Crossroads Life Center
- Volunteered at the YMCA
- Did a variety of service projects, including landscaping, painting, and moving furniture for Glasgow, Barren, and Metcalfe schools
- Led chapel services and did room visits in nursing homes in Hart, Barren, and Metcalfe Counties
- Conducted a free carwash in town where donations were not accepted.
- Facilitated a Food Drive for Next Step in partnership with Houchens
- Did multiple projects for the City and County, including landscaping on the square, painting at Gorin Park, and reconstructing a wall at Fort Williams
- Built benches for teachers at Red Cross Elementary School
- Loved on residents at the State Hospital
- Served at Refuge BG
- Planted flowers and visited with a 93-year-old widow
- Completed projects at seven homes
 - o This included things such as:
 - o Serving a wife and her disabled husband by building a ramp, installing a hot water heater, and working on plumbing (they have not had hot water in 7 years!!!!)
 - o Serving at a couple's home, constructing a ramp, and deep cleaning
 - o Tearing out and rebuilding a porch for an elderly couple, pressure washed another deck
 - o Serving a wife and disabled husband by painting and landscaping
 - o Rebuilding and adding to an existing ramp for a disabled couple
 - \circ $\;$ Weed-eating, pressure washing, and general cleanup for a single mom.
 - Storm cleanup for an elderly lady

Approx. 3,600 volunteer hours served. It would take a full-time worker 90 weeks to put in those hours!
